The end of another term and now half way through the year and so much has been done. The term has been highlighted by assessment information gathered in Writing, Basic Facts, Science and Reading showing that the bulk of our children are at or above expected levels. We are not at the 90% level we hope to achieve but are making progress toward that mark.

The arrival of several new students during the term resulted in us completing our July 1st return to the Ministry of Education with 98 students on the roll. This figure is set to increase by the end of the year with new entrant enrolments. The total as at today is 101 and we have requested a staffing increase from the Ministry based on this number.

The Lower Waipa 7's day was held at Ngahinapouri. The results showed our teams at this event competed with credit, spirit and respect. Trips to the Museum, Windfarm and interhouse events have made this a busy yet rewarding term for all. We look forward to term three, Lower Waipa Cross Country, Jump Rope for Heart, Healthy Eating initiatives and the usual array of interesting learning opportunities.

National Standards –

As part of each child's Learning Journal you will note an important piece of documentation. This indicates the child's progress toward meeting the required standard for their age and year level, some of whom are already meeting it. For others the indication will be that they are slightly below or well below. Throughout the journal reference is made as to those things which will help progress the child in their learning and it is these aspects we will be focussing on and ask that you give as much support to these as you possibly can.
