One week to go until the end of term holiday and it seems like most are ready for it. The children seem particularly tired and some a little grumpy, but we remain focussed on learning and reinforcing our values regardless of the circumstances as we all need to learn how to cope and remain on task.

### Learning Journals –

I was delighted to read each of these journals and note the efforts and developments of each child. These journals will be sent home next week and I encourage you to spend time going through the achievements of your child and encouraging them to take note of the advice to help them make the next steps in their learning. Support from home of these recommendations and our nightly Reading and Mathematics programmes is important if continual progress is to be made.

### National Standards –

As part of each child's Learning Journal you will note two important pieces of documentation. The first indicates the child's progress toward meeting the required standard for their age and year level, some of whom are already meeting it. For others the indication will be that they are slightly below or well below. Throughout the journal reference is made as to those things which will help progress the child in their learning and it is these aspects we will be focussing on and ask that you give as much support to these as you possibly can.

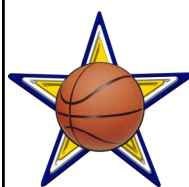

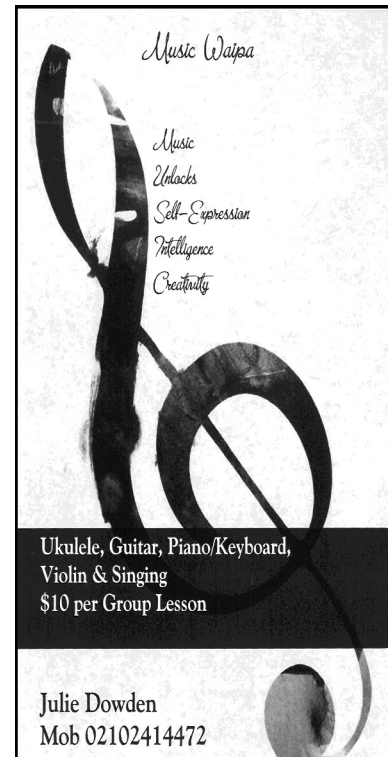
