Agricultural Day.

Pre day activities:	<u>At least 3 to be completed by children who do not have lambs, goats or calves.</u>	Baking counts as one choice even if you do all 3 baking sections. Two activities must be done at school.
Model farm:	Made at home. Can be reassembled at school or brought already assembled. Display-Hall	Farms that use mostly natural materials do better in this section. The farm can be made in a roasting dish or similar vessel. Use materials like, dirt, sawdust, sticks, moss, wood, grass etc...
Animal Sculpture:	Made at home. Display-Hall	This is a good holiday project. Make your animal out of Paper Mache, Lego, recycled materials, card, wood, metal etc...
Photography:	Done prior to Ag day. A children's section and an adult section. There are four categories, junior, intermediate, senior and adult. Each photo needs to be named on the back with a caption under the photo. The maximum size of the photo is A5 (15 X 21cm) but it can be smaller. Display- Hall	The aim of the photograph is to show the relationship between the child and their animal. The child section of the photography is about the child's ability to take photos of animals. Each photo needs to have a caption at the bottom of it. You need to have the photo printed and ready hand into the office on the first day of Term 4, no later. The photo is judged, not the presentation.
Baking:		
Muffins-	Made at home. Displayed in the Hall	Only 3 on a plate please and not iced. Childs age on a piece of paper with their name on underside of paper.

Cupcakes-	Made at home. Displayed in the Hall	Only 3 on a plate please and must be decorated. Childs age on a piece of paper with their name on underside of paper.
Pikelets-	Made at home. Displayed in the Hall.	Only 3 on a plate , plain and unbuttered. Childs age on a piece of paper with their name on underside of paper.
Whanau Cake	Done at home. Displayed in the Hall.	Cake of any flavour, baked and decorated at home. Give the cake a title and list the main ingredients .
Agricultural Day Activities:	<u>Strictly To Be Done on the day at school.</u> <u>These will be done in house groups</u>	<i>Children with animals can do the at-home crafts but will not be doing the in-class activities</i>
Flower arrangement.	Vase and flowers brought to school, arrangement done at school, by the child. Displayed in the Hall	Vase can be a jar covered with paper, or filled with coloured stones or coloured water. Vary the height of your flowers and use a mixture of foliage and flowers.
Sand saucer.	Saucer and flowers brought to school, arrangement done at school, by the child. Displayed in the Hall	Aim to cover all the sand with flowers, petals or leaves or a combination.
Natural Pet Craft	Pine cones will be supplied... Suggestions to assist in making your creation: driftwood, felt, card, acorns, recycled buttons, feathers, shells, seeds etc...	The creation <u>must</u> be made at school by the child. Get collecting over the holidays. Try out some ideas beforehand. Take a look on Pintrest for inspiration. Try to be as natural as possible, and use recycled items if you can.
<i>Rock Art</i>	Each child will bring a rock to paint, design and create with.	This creation is done at school
